

**MINUTES OF THE PROCEEDINGS OF THE
CITY COUNCIL OF WHITTEMORE, IOWA
-SPECIAL MEETING-
*Wednesday, May 9, 2007 – 11:30 A.M.***

Members of the Whittemore City Council met in Special Session on Wednesday, May 9, 2007 at 11:30 A.M. in the Chambers of City Hall with Mayor Elbert presiding. Present were Simonson, Dahlhauser, Setzer, Brownell and Muller. Absent: none.

Mayor Elbert read a letter from Mary Ellen Meyer requesting her application be withdrawn for consideration for the part-time (permanent) position of Deputy City Clerk, and with regret, the Council accepted her request.

The Council then entered into CLOSED SESSION at 11:35 A.M. to review five applications for employment for the position of part-time (permanent) Deputy City Clerk.

The Council returned to OPEN SESSION at 12:07 P.M.

Per decision by closed ballot, Andrea Thompson was appointed Deputy City Clerk of Whittemore, to serve on a part-time basis (less than 25 hrs. per week, or on an “as needed” basis). Per motion by Brownell and a second by Dahlhauser, Andrea Thompson (pending her acceptance of the position) to receive \$9.00 per hour, less appropriate deductions, with salary review in June, 2008 for the fiscal year 2008-2009. Vote was all AYES; motion carried.

The Clerk was instructed to send thank-you letters to all applicants.

There being no further business to come before the Council, Mayor Elbert declared the May 9, 2007 Special Meeting adjourned at 12:15 P.M.
