

ORDINANCE NO. 168

AMENDMENT OF THE WHITTEMORE MUNICIPAL CODE OF ORDINANCES, SECTION 3-3-28 TO INCLUDE a \$25.00 FINE PER INCIDENT, AS THE ORDINANCE PERTAINS TO *PARKING DURING SNOW EMERGENCY*:

SECTION 1. SECTION MODIFIED. Section 3-3-28 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Whittemore, Iowa, 2007, is repealed and the following adopted in lieu thereof:

3-3-28 **PARKING DURING SNOW EMERGENCY.** No person shall park, abandon, or leave unattended any vehicle on any public street, alley, or City-owned off-street parking area during the time the snow or ice begins to accumulate through the duration of the snow or ice storm unless the snow or ice has been removed or plowed from said street, alley, or parking area and the snow or ice has ceased to fall.

The ban shall be enforced whenever the parking of a vehicle interferes with the removal of snow or ice. If the owner of a vehicle in violation of this ban fails to promptly remove such vehicle, the vehicle will receive a \$25.00 citation (per violation) and a towing service will be contacted (per violation) for the purpose of removing said vehicle at the owner's expense.

SECTION 2. REPEALER. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provision of this ordinance shall be adjudged invalid or unconstitutional; such adjudication shall not affect the validity of the ordinance as a whole, or any section, provision or part thereof not adjudged invalid or unconstitutional.



SECTION 4. WHEN EFFECTIVE. This ordinance shall be in effect upon passage and required publication.
